P: Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love;
 C: **According to your great compassion blot out my transgressions.**
 P: Wash away all my iniquity
 C: **And cleanse me from my sin.**
 P: For I know my transgressions
 C: **And my sin is always before me.**
 P: Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight,
 C: **So that you are proved right when you speak and justified when you judge.**
 P: Surely I have been a sinner from birth,
 C: **Sinful from the time my mother conceived me.**
 P: Surely you desire truth in the inner parts;
 C: **You teach me wisdom in the inmost place.**
 P: Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean
 C: **Wash me, and I will be whiter than snow.**
 P: Let me hear joy and gladness;
 C: **Let the bones you have crushed rejoice.**
 P: Hide your face from my sins
 C: **And blot out all my iniquity.**
 P: Create in me a pure heart, O God,
 C: **And renew a steadfast spirit within me.**
 P: Do not cast me from your presence
 C: **Or take your Holy Spirit from me.**
 P: Restore to me the joy of your salvation

C: And grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.
